Situation



- Every site has a set of essential Channel Access command line tools.
- Most sites even have multiple versions (up to four) with slightly different features.
- These versions are of course incompatible, tests that rely on one version break with the others.









Include a minimal set of command line tools into EPICS base:

caget	get PV value
caput	put PV value
camonitor	set up CA monitor
cainfo	get meta information

These will be statically linked and are meant as debugging tools only – using them in scripts is *not* advisable.
