About NUFO (National User Facility Organization)



- Represents 30 federally funded national user facilities
 - More than 30,000 users (scientists/engineers)
 - **560** universities in all 50 states; 400 foreign institutions
 - Approximately 7100 graduate students whose degrees will be based, at least in part, on research at NUFO facilities
 - 350 U.S.-based industrial firms/companies; 200 international firms
- Dual focus: advocacy for science and benchmarking best user practices
- Elected/appointed Steering Committee
- Annual Meetings: last one at Argonne on June 10-12, 2009; next year at BNL
- Outreach event planned: Washington DC on October 15, 2009

Workshop on Industrial Participation at National User Facilities: June 11, 2009

Purpose:

- Examine issues surrounding industrial use of national user facilities
- Recommend solutions to real or perceived barriers for industry
- Provide a report to DOE/BES, other sponsors, facilities management with recommendations for action
- Participants: 111 individuals from DOE Program Offices, other sponsors, industrial firms, user facilities
- Five major issues identified
- Recommendations on each issue for sponsors, user facilities, NUFO
- Report requested by Dr. Harriet Kung, Director, BES will be sent this week



Issue 1: Intellectual property agreements vary among user facilities in the United States and worldwide

- Despite DOE efforts to standardize user agreements across facilities, many variations still remain.
 - NIST and NSF-funded facilities also differ
 - US facilities often not competitive with foreign facilities
- Recommendations
 - For sponsors:
 - Survey industrial users about concerns; work with facilities to respond
 - For facilities
 - Examine institutional processes that delay access
 - For NUFO
 - Benchmark intellectual property practices of user facilities (both national and international) to determine if changes are needed to facilitate industrial access



Issue 2: There is limited awareness by industry of capabilities and access models for user facilities

- Recommendations
 - For facilities:
 - Develop outreach mechanisms to reach industrial users at relevant conferences
 - Identify an industrial liaison
 - Provide examples of industrial applications on facility Web pages
 - Improve promotional activities for small businesses
 - Enable easy access among multiple beamlines, instruments, facilities
 - For NUFO:
 - Identify and promote best practices
 - Identify key meetings, journals, organizations for outreach to industry
 - Specific industry-oriented Web page on NUFO site



Issue 3: It takes too long to access a user facility for a time-sensitive industrial experiment

Recommendations

- For sponsors:
 - Accept a variety of approaches to accommodate industrial access (potentially different review approaches or measures of success)
- For facilities:
 - Develop a facility access model that accommodates industrial time frames (e.g., standing fast-track system)
- For NUFO:
 - Benchmark facility proposal submission, review, allocation processes to identify best practices for facilitating industrial research within industry's time constraints



Issue 4: Industrial users typically need more assistance with proposals, experiments, data analysis

- Recommendations
 - For sponsors:
 - Include metrics for facility reviews that recognize the value of industrial research
 - For facilities:
 - Include career advancement incentives for staff to assist industrial users (not necessarily peer-reviewed publications)
 - Develop Web-based tools
 - Analyze acceptance rates for industrial proposals to determine if rate is appropriate when compared with other categories of user proposals
 - For NUFO:
 - Include facility-developed information and software tools on NUFO Web site



Issue 5: Facility-specific barriers inhibit the effective use of user facilities by industry

- Recommendations
 - For facilities:
 - Charter an advisory committee with representatives from industrial institutions
 - Operate instruments and facilities for optimal performance and limited downtime
 - Include industrial representatives on facility review and advisory committees
 - For NUFO:
 - Identify, in collaboration with user groups, typical barriers and bring them to the attention of the facilities and users at large
 - Review progress at 2010 annual meeting
