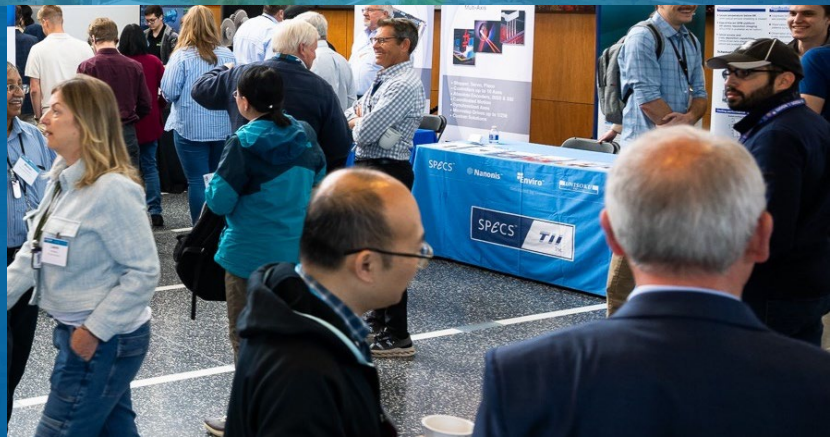

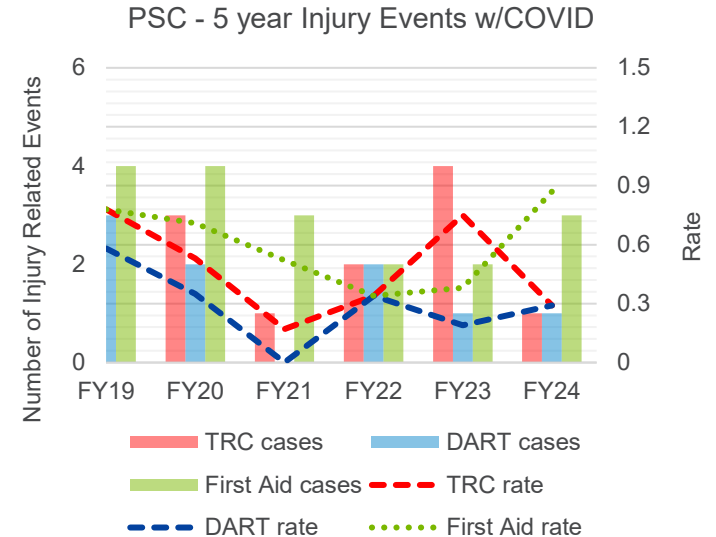
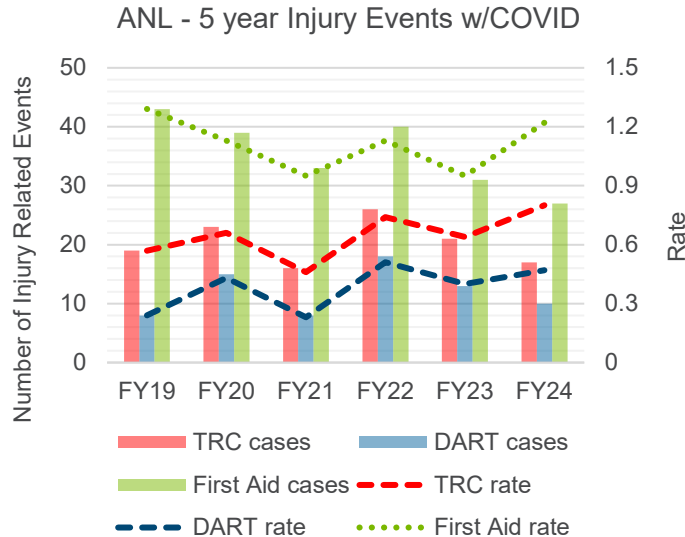

Riggers come every Thursday to pick up trash from beamline component deliveries, construction work

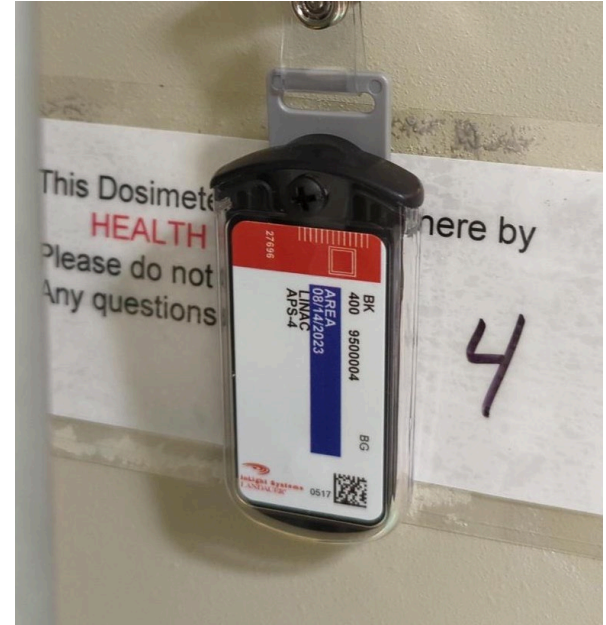
WHAT WE'LL DO MORE OF

Riggers will come every **Tuesday** and **Thursday** to facilitate cleaner, safer workspaces



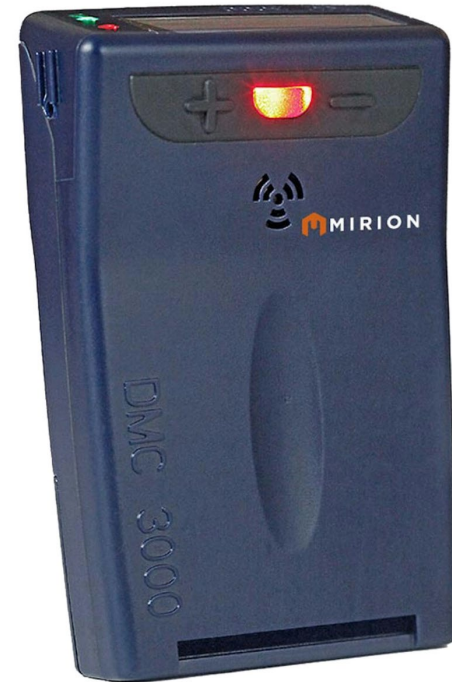
SAFETY PAUSE – COMMUNICATIONS ON RADIATION SAFETY

- **We studied worst case plausible scenarios**
 - Rates are very low and what we expect to see
 - We will continue to survey most impacted areas at least weekly
- **Additional personnel being trained to issue personal dosimeters**
 - Please request 2 weeks before needed
 - Thanks for your patience

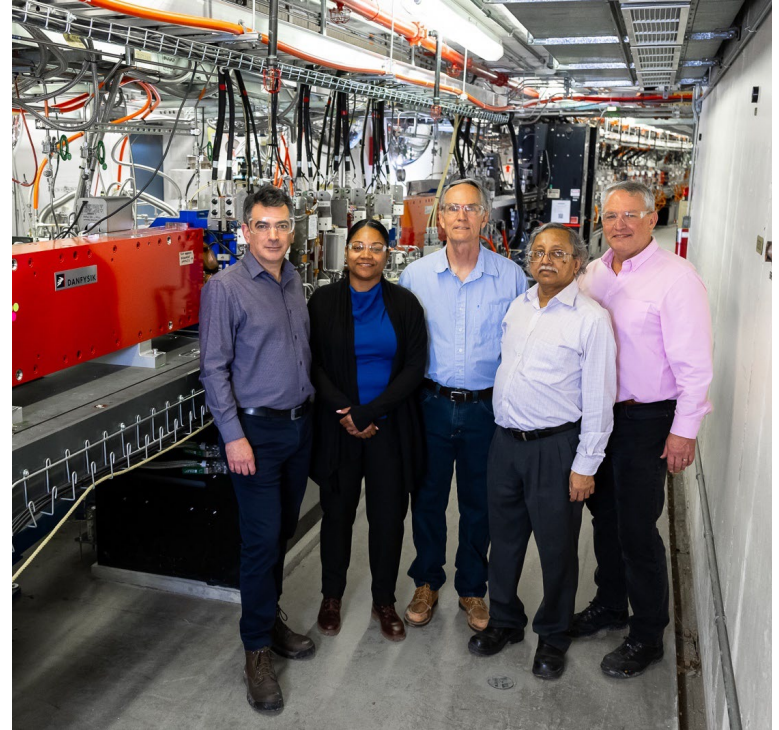
SAFETY PAUSE – LEADERSHIP ENGAGEMENT AND WORK PLANNING
